We start off the week in the Caribbean as the students are able to explore Dunnis River Falls in Jamaica, and learn their National Anthem and dance to some Reggae music. Then everyone will travel to Puerto Rico. Here, we will learn about the Coqui Frog, how they have no large mammals, and talk about the Hibiscus Flower. It's now time to head to Central America! On Wednesday we visit Honduras, which is home to the Mayan ruins and the Scarlett McCaw, and some amazing foods like Beledadas and Horchata!
