What We Learned

This week we continued to talk about rhyming words, breaking words down into two syllables and the first sound we hear in words, they are all doing great.

We talked about outdoor exercises and drew a picture of ourselves or someone else doing outdoor exercises. We have some fantastic artist in our class.

We learned what a triathlon was and even made our own indoor triathlon using hula hoops, they had so much fun with this. We also played Freeze Dance, they loved the dancing and did an amazing job following directions.

We read Have You Filled a Bucket Today, a terrific book about friendship. We also read What Should Danny Do?, this is a wonderful book that let's the children make choices of what Danny should do and teaches them about the out come of each choice...we had fun making different choices and creating a new story each time we read it.

We had a visit from the museum on Monday, we learned about three of the seven continents, Asia, South America and Africa. We played instruments from South America and learned about Children's Day in Japan. We even had a parade using Koi fish flags like they have in Japan.

This week in STEM we learned about coding. Coding is instructions for a device (phone, computer, machine and more) to follow to help it complete its assigned task. We used Matatalab to get comfortable with coding. This is a fun and easy way to learn, fix mistakes and keep trying and learn how to get easier results. With Matatalab you have a starting point and ending point. You lay out simple directions and the robot follows them, if your robot turns the direction you didn't want it to go its an easy change! This is a fun way to get their math and problem-solving skills going. Once the kids get more comfortable with coding they can then start coming up with their own games, tricks and more!
